## Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 (TPCA 1847)

### THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (THE HALIFAX 10K) TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER 2026

1. The Borough Council of Calderdale (Council) gives notice that it has made an Order under section 21 of the TPCA 1847 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway in Sowerby Bridge being
  - a) Station Road,
  - b) Holmes Road, Mearclough Road, Copley Valley Road, Hollas Lane,
  - c) Wakefield Road.
  - d) Fall Lane at the junction with Mearclough Road.
2. The Order is made to avoid obstruction of the highway specified in paragraph 1 during the following event:  
The Halifax 10K.
3. The Order shall come into operation at 07.00 hours and will remain in force until 12.00 hours on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026.
4. While the order is on operation, traffic including bicycle and equestrian movement along the highway specified in paragraph 1 will be temporarily restricted due to a temporary closure (except for emergency access), between
  - a) 07.00 hours and 12.00 hours on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026.
  - b) 08.00 hours and 12.00 hours on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026
  - c) 08.00 hours and 10.30 hours (east of Copley Lane between 08.00 hours and 10.00 hours) on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026.
  - d) 07.00 hours and 12.00 hours on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2026.
5. An alternative route will be available for use while the Order is in force being
  - a) b) & c) via Bolton Brow, Pye Nest Road, Rochdale Road, Dry Clough Lane, Huddersfield Road and vice versa.
  - d) Spark House Lane, Sowerby Croft Lane, Watson Mill Lane, West Street and vice versa.
6. All restrictions will be signed and / or staffed and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.
7. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - Any vehicle engaged in the relevant event.
  - Anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer.
  - Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency, such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water to premises in the area, which requires vehicles to be brought onto a section of highway to which the Order applies.
8. Access to properties adjoining the highway specified in paragraph 1 will not be affected by the Order.
